

The following clarifications and recommendations for change are to be effective for the 2024-2025 season, scheduled to begin August 1, 2024.



RULES & POLICIES

WILL BE UPDATED AND POSTED ON THE WEBSITE

PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE TO ALL MEMBERS



DECLARATION DATE (Friendly Reminder)

An athlete may NOT drop back to a division/lower level in a competitive season <u>AFTER</u> the declaration date.

SAC determines prior to the beginning of the competitive year, a designated "declaration" date for each level for this purpose.

The highest level / division competed at a sanctioned competition after the "declaration" date will determine the program (Dev / Xcel) for which the athlete can compete for the remainder of that season.



DROPPING BACK WITHIN DIVISIONS (Friendly Reminder)

If an athlete competed at an Xcel State Championships (or higher) and wishes to drop back through the divisions, her coach must submit a "reason for change" letter.

- For Bronze, Silver, and Gold Divisions, the letter is sent to the SACC to be considered by the SAC (State Administrative Committee).
- For Platinum, Diamond, and Sapphire Divisions, the letter is sent to the RTCC to be considered by the RAC (Regional Administrative Committee).

DEV athlete wishes to enter the Xcel Program in a division <u>below</u> the allowable division, her coach must submit a "reason for change" letter:

• **DEV Level 8 and Below**, letter to the SACC for approval.

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• **DEV Level 9 or 10 athlete**, letter sent to RTCC for approval.



ADDITIONAL STATE REPRESENTATION

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Identify all overseas military bases and assign athletes to appropriate state/region, in conjunction with military base contact, NACC and national office. Military bases would follow guidelines of each respective state, with any possible exception requests made at the discretion of the SAC.



MEMBER CONDUCT

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No cigarettes, e-cigarettes/vapes or any other smoking paraphernalia are allowed in the venue.

No firearms or dangerous weapons are allowed in the venue.



MANDATE SCORE

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USA Gymnastics CANNOT require/mandate a gymnast to move up to a higher level/division.



DEFINING IES ATHLETES

Individual Event Specialist/IES
 An athlete who competes 3 events or less

All-Around athletes An athlete who competes all 4 events

*Exceptions as written still apply

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DEFINING UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

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Unforeseen = Unpredictable circumstances

If a gymnast is unable to compete with her designated age group, she may compete on another day (or in another session) with the approval of the SACC for State Championships and RACC for Regional Championships.



DEFINING UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

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Competition schedules are set using available dates without regard to the diversity of religious and cultural practices of potential participants.

USA Gymnastics acknowledges and regrets that athletes may have to choose to opt out of participation in any specific competition due to religious practices or scheduling conflicts.



ATHLETE RELOCATION

Athlete relocates residences between state and regional meets (placing them in a different region):

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 ALL Xcel divisions - ALLOWED to compete in new region, but MUST meet qualifying requirements of that region and qualification was by score, not rank of athletes.



MEMBERS ALLOWED ON FIELD OF PLAY

Membership roles that are allowed on the field of play. 1. Athlete 2. Competitive Coach 2. Judge 3. Meet Director 4. Volunteer* 5. Photographer/Videographer* 6. Medical* *Must be contracted by the Meet Director

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ENTRY FEES – STATE & REGIONAL

Consistency between State and Regional entry fee maximums:

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- State Championships: determined by SAC and MUST be approved by RACC, may NOT exceed Regional Championship meet entry fee.
- Regional Championships: determined by RAC and MUST be approved by NACC, may NOT exceed National Championship meet entry fee.



INJURED ATHLETES

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Only competing gymnasts and coach(es) allowed
 onto field of play, only during session they are
 competing.

At Meet Director's discretion and at invitationals ONLY, may include gymnasts who were <u>entered</u> / scheduled for session but scratched due to injury.



(Clarification)

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- If a competition runs only 2 events at a time:
 - Number of competitors per session= half of maximum allowable competitors for that level or division.

DELAY OF COMPETITION PROCEDURES

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Any situation regarding delay of competition on the field of play (i.e. equipment failure, athlete injury, unforeseen circumstances, etc.):

 Meet Director, in conjunction with Meet Referee, will assess the situation to make appropriate call regarding additional warm-up time.



OFFICIALS

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- When assigning judges to a competition with multiple days:
 - Rotate the assigned events each day ONLY IF meet has separate awards ceremonies for each session.



OFFICIALS COMPENSATION

4 - Judge Panel:

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At all Dev and Xcel Regional **Championship meets**, the daily rate, (min 4 hours-up to 8 hours) will increase \$20.00 per day for Brevet and National rated judges, and \$10.00 per day for Levels 8-10 rated judges.

This would bring the Championship fees to:

	Full Day	Half Day
Brevet	\$250.00	\$125.00
National	\$240.00	\$120.00
Level 10	\$220.00	\$110.00
Level 9	\$210.00	\$105.00
Level 7/8	\$200.00	\$100.00

The regular hourly rate after 8 hours remains the same.



OFFICIALS COMPENSATION

2-Judge Panel:

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At all Dev and Xcel Regional Championship Meets that utilize a 2-judge panel, Championship fees (the daily rate) <u>does not</u> apply. Regular hourly fees will be calculated.

• The additional \$10.00 per day Chief Judge fee remains in effect.



VIDEO REVIEW

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If a video review results in the awarding of a
 Special Requirement or Value Part: The
 judging panel may apply deductions related
 only to the reason for the video review.
 Additional deductions for execution are not
 applied.



VIDEO REVIEW

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Judging panel is allowed to review the submitted video once the video review process has been finalized.



ALLOWABLE ATHLETE APPAREL

Shorts or tights allowed

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- Can be capri length or longer that **match the leotard**, **are black**, **or match the athletes skin tone**.
- May be worn under or over the leotard.
- A small manufacturer's branding allowed, but no embellishments.

Unitards may have long legs to the ankle or short length and may be with or without sleeves.



ALLOWABLE FLOOR MUSIC – 8/1/2026

Beginning August 1, 2026:

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- The use of human voice in floor music to
 create words, sounds, chanting, etc. will
 no longer be allowed.
 - A <u>1.00</u> CJ deduction will be taken for any floor music with voice.



GENERAL

CODE OF POINTS

DEDUCTION

Remove the <u>0.50</u> Chief Judge deduction for Starting the exercise before signal is given or Vaults without signal from Chief Judge.





CODE OF POINTS

DEDUCTION

Update the Short Exercise deduction to indicate Short exercise with fewer than three (3) **attempted or spotted** value parts. - 2.00 deduction.








VAULT

CODE OF POINTS

VAULT (Deductions)

Remove the <u>1.00</u> Chief Judge (CJ) deduction for the performance of a Vault with only one hand.

The <u>1.00</u> deduction will now be applied by all judges under the Support phase.





VAULT (ALLOWABLE SCORE RANGE)

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Whenever a <u>1.00</u> or greater flat deduction is applied, the allowable score range does NOT apply, instead, scores will be averaged.



VAULT (Silver – Sapphire)

Apply the up to 0.10 deduction for under rotation - Silver - Sapphire Divisions.





VAULT (Platinum)

Modify the start value at **Platinum** to **9.90**

#	Vault	NEW VALUE	OLD VALUE
4.102	RO, FF on - Repulsion off with ½ (180°) turn	9.90	9.70
1.104	Yamashita with ½ (180°) turn off	9.90	10.0







BARS

BARS (After a fall)

In order to resume the routine after a fall, a coach may assist the gymnast onto the bar with no deduction, regardless if the remounting skill was a value part listed in the Xcel Code of Points. Judging resumes with the subsequent skill.





BARS (Elements considered different)

Elements with the same element number are considered different when performed in a different direction.

Example, #7.101 Hip circle backward or forward. **7.101** Hip circle backward on LB or HB to support

Hip circle forward on LB or HB to support







BARS (Deduction)

Apply 0.20 Chief Judge (CJ) deduction if a coach sprays water or chalks the bar once the exercise has begun, no warning will be given.





CODE OF POINTS

BARS (Deduction)

Remove the **up to .40** amplitude deduction for clear hip circles at the Platinum Division.

Clear hip circles are a "B" VP as long as clear of the bar. This will fulfill SR#2. (Remove Platinum from chart on Uneven Bars - 25)





BARS (Deduction)

Apply a <u>0.10</u> amplitude deduction to <u>any</u> cast/clear support element that does not meet the Division angle requirement.

Any cast/clear support element that is within 10° of the Division angle requirement **will receive VP and SR**.





Rationale for Application By Division

Division	Application	
Bronze	Does not apply to Bronze – No angle requirement	
Silver - Diamond	d Applied to any cast/clear support that does not meet the angle requirement. Any cast/clear support within 10° will receive VP and SR.	
Sapphire	 The angle requirement will continue to allow for up to 10° without deduction and is considered meeting the Division angle requirement. For this Division apply as follows: 0-10°: No amplitude deduction, Receive VP and SR 11-20°: Deduct 0.10 amplitude, Receive VP and SR Below 20°: Deduct 0.10 amplitude Do not receive SR. Apply VP as applicable based on the element performed. 	

BARS DISMOUNTS – VALUE CHANGE

RAISE - BARS #8.301 ("C") Underswing toe-on or clear, front pike with ½ twist variation to BARS #8.401 ("D")

REMOVE - BARS #8.401 ("D") Underswing toe-on or clear, **front pike with <u>1/1</u> twist** variation From HB – underswing (toe-on or clear) or back stalder (not illustrated) to salto forward tucked or piked

also with 1/2 (180°) twist





BARS DISMOUNTS – VALUE CHANGE

Raise - Bars **#8.301 variation** - Back Stalder to front salto tucked (Celestine) or piked with ½ twist to **#8.401 ("D").**

Back stalder to salto forward tucked w/ 1/2 twist (Celestine)





BARS – HIGH BAR


CODE OF POINTS

Add HB option - #2.102 Cast to squat, stoop, or straddle on LB or HB.

2.102

Cast to squat, stoop or straddle on LB, also with jump to grasp HB

(One "A" VP in all Divisions)





BARS (Text Clarifications)

- Long Hang Pullover: A long hang pullover is considered a 360° circling skill only if preceded by a cast for Platinum & Diamond.
 - Remove Diamond reference as the Diamond SR is a "B"
- Diamond/Sapphire: SR requirements for circling skills - Clarify <u>Not mount or dismount</u> within SR language.
- Mount: Spotting blocks <u>may not</u> be used to mount
 the high bar.





BEAM

BEAM – NEW ELEMENT VARIATION

Variation of #9.901-Head Spring





BEAM – VALUE CHANGE

Raise - #2.201 variation -Split or stag-split leap forward (take off from one leg) with ¼ turn (90°) turn to straddle position (side leap) ("B") to **#2.301** ("C"). Split or stag-split leap forward (take-off from one leg) with 1/4 (90°) turn to straddle position (Side leap)



BEAM – VALUE CHANGE

Raise - # 3.307 - 1¼ turn on back in kip position ("C") to **# 3.407 ("D").**

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CODE

3.307 1¼ (450°) turn on back in kip position (hip-leg angle closed) (LiLi)

BEAM – Description Language

#9.001 in Xcel COP-Dismount - Any jump from **one or two** feet, also with up to 360° turn.

#5.001 - From a lunge or stand, Lever to touch beam.

BRONZE/SILVER ONLY 9.001


Any Jump from feet, also with up to 360° Turn (No visual available)

BRONZE ONLY

5.001

Lever to touch Beam:

- Free leg at horizontal or above No angle requirements
- Body shape deductions may apply
- Lever back foot need not return to beam to receive VP credit





BEAM (Element Clarifications)

- #5.002 Partial Handstand with feet closed together and at a minimum of 45° from Vertical, both criteria to be met simultaneously to receive "A" VP. – Also allowed for BRONZE Division
- #8.401 ADD also with ¼ turn
- Stag Leap: When the front leg on a leap is in the stag position it cannot be used for the split SR. Front leg must be extended in the split position.



BEAM (Text Clarification)

- Sapphire SR#2 Reword for consistency with other Divisions
 - Dance Series -Minimum of Two Group 1*, 2 or 3* elements (same or different)-AND one (1) Leap or Jump with a minimum 180° Cross or Side Split (Isolated or in a Series).








BEAM/FLOOR

BEAM, FLOOR

When a Leap / Jump that is more than 20° (Bronze-Diamond) or 45° (Sapphire) from the required split angle in the Division:

- Update text with "apply appropriate deductions to applicable VP performed".
- **Remove** references to the insufficient leg separation of up to 0.20

This change is **ONLY** cleaning up language in the Code/Appendix when the split angle is more than the allowed deficiency.





REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Recommendation to the Women's Program Committee (WPC): **ADD** – Assist in the organization of clinics, camps, petitions, administrative work, newsletters, and correspondence.

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Requires a Vote by the WPC to adopt (June Meeting)



REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE CHAIR (RTCC) NOMINATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Recommendation to the Women's **Program Committee (WPC):** ADD - Must have been assigned to judge East/West and Development National Championships (formerly JO National Championships) in the current or previous cycle.

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Requires a Vote by the WPC to adopt (June Meeting)
